

## 2025-2026 Minister's Appreciation Grant \*

Legal dependents of ordained Southern Baptist ministers currently employed or retired from a Southern Baptist Church or legal dependents of ordained ministers currently employed or retired from a New Testament church outside the Southern Baptist denomination are eligible to apply. This is in addition to other merit-based scholarships and not stackable with talent-based aid. The grant is valued at \$1000 annually and may be awarded for a maximum of eight semesters; however, maximum aggregate eligibility will be pro-rated for entering transfer students and upperclassmen receiving this award for the first time (for example, a second semester sophomore who receives the scholarship for the first time will be eligible for a maximum of five semesters).

\*Definition of Legal Dependent for Minister's Dependent Grant: A legal dependent is defined, for the purposes of this grant, as a person who is claimed by the ordained minister of a Southern Baptist/New Testament church on his federal income tax return and/or by the results of the FAFSA. If a student who is claimed as a dependent of a minister marries while attending the University of Mobile, he/she is no longer eligible to receive the Minister's Dependent Grant.
